- #10 an article about anything related to a planet other than Earth (chapter 24)
- #11 an article about anything related to stars or galaxies (chapter 25)
- #12 an article about anything related to the atmosphere or air pollution (chapter 15)
- #13 an article about anything related to the weather (chapter 16)

You will then write a summary of each of the articles by following the criteria on the following page.

CRITERIA:

- YOU MAY NOT USE INTERNET BASED ARTICLES UNLESS THEY ARE FROM AN ACCEPTABLE WEBSITE. IF YOU ARE NOT SURE WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE, YOU MUST GET THE ARTICLE INITIALED BY MR. ZUNICK.
- All summaries must be 2 paragraphs.
- All summaries must be typed. HANDWRITTEN SUMMARIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED FOR ANY REASON WHATSOEVER.
- All summaries must include an introductory statement and a concluding statement.
- Your articles will be graded based on content (information) and English skills (spelling, punctuation, grammar, etc.).
- If your article includes a controversial topic, you should include your point of view.
- All articles must be of an appropriate length. If the article is extremely short, you will not be able to write a summary. IF YOU ARE NOT SURE WHAT IS ACCEPTABLE, YOU MUST GET THE ARTICLE INITIALED BY MR. ZUNICK.
- Articles that are too short WILL NOT BE GRADED.
- All summaries must be typed on a separate sheet of paper.
- All summaries must include the following information at the top of the page:
 - * your name
 - * article title
 - * author's name
 - * source (name of newspaper, magazine, or website)
- On the due date, assemble your project as follows:
 - * summary #1 stapled in front of article #1
 - * then... summary #2 stapled in front of article #2
 - * then... summary #3 stapled in front of article #3
 - * and so on...
